

Hello Mayor Campbell and Members of the City Commission,

Thank you for the opportunity to speak to you today to highlight some serious concerns my neighbors and I have identified that will, in our estimation, significantly impact our daily lives.

As a resident of Coral Springs for 31 years I've voted in every election since age 18, yet have never been pro-active about any issue or attended a government meeting until today. My presence is a reflection of the urgency on this matter.

Specifically, I am speaking to you about two separate proposals being considered by the city:

1) the potential construction of a Costco on the NE corner of Wiles Rd & Coral Ridge

**AND**

2) the potential move of the Charter School to Betti Stradling Park

Having lived 19 or those 31 years in the Wyndham Lakes/NW part of Coral Springs, we've seen immense growth in this area. We have reached the maximum threshold where today traffic is a huge problem. According to the Florida Dept of Transportation, currently the daily traffic flows along Wiles Road and the cross streets of Coral Ridge and Coral Springs Drive number between 24,000 to 27,500 cars AND between 711 to 935 trucks each and every day. That is incomprehensible and causes gridlock and multiple challenges. We also have existing school zones locally which while extremely important for obvious reasons, add to the traffic challenges that are generated on Wiles Road.

That said, we do NOT need a Costco in this section of Coral Springs. It would be an unnecessary addition to our quiet serene neighborhood. Costco brings with it tractor trailer deliveries throughout the day starting as early as 4 and 5 am. We don't need the noise those deliveries would bring, not to mention the garbage that would accumulate (attracting rodents and such). Costco would create tons of additional traffic to which you may suggest lets expand the roads. But, to which we say NO. Instead we should retain the simplicity of 'Our Town'. A Costco would take away from the beautiful residential aspect of all the nearby home communities. And, it would backup to home owners properties providing them a horrific view in their backyards of dumpsters, parking spots, and backs of buildings. Which in turn would no doubt significantly reduce property values. Costco would NOT improve things in anyway. We already have a Super Walmart 2 minutes down the road ... that is enough.

Additionally, it is inconceivable that there is a suggestion being discussed to move the Charter School to Betti Stradling Park. The residents of Coral Springs worked VERY hard to establish Betti Stradling Park to intentionally secure green "pastures" in our city to enjoy indefinitely without the worry of it ever being taken away (even partially). And, the implication that any resident would somehow 'benefit' from such a move is a misnomer and 'selling point', which in reality is far from the truth. We would gain nothing and we would certainly lose a park.

The city needs to rein in the apparent desire to cause chaos on Wiles Road. PLEASE consider the negative impacts both these projects would cause. Crime would go up, noise levels increased, traffic would be impossible, home values would decline, all for no solid reason unless there are financial gains to be had which are typically the basis for most decisions, unfair as that may be.

Wiles Road should NOT be a dumping ground for further unnecessary growth.

Thank you for taking time to reflect and walk in the shoes of residents in close proximity to both sites.

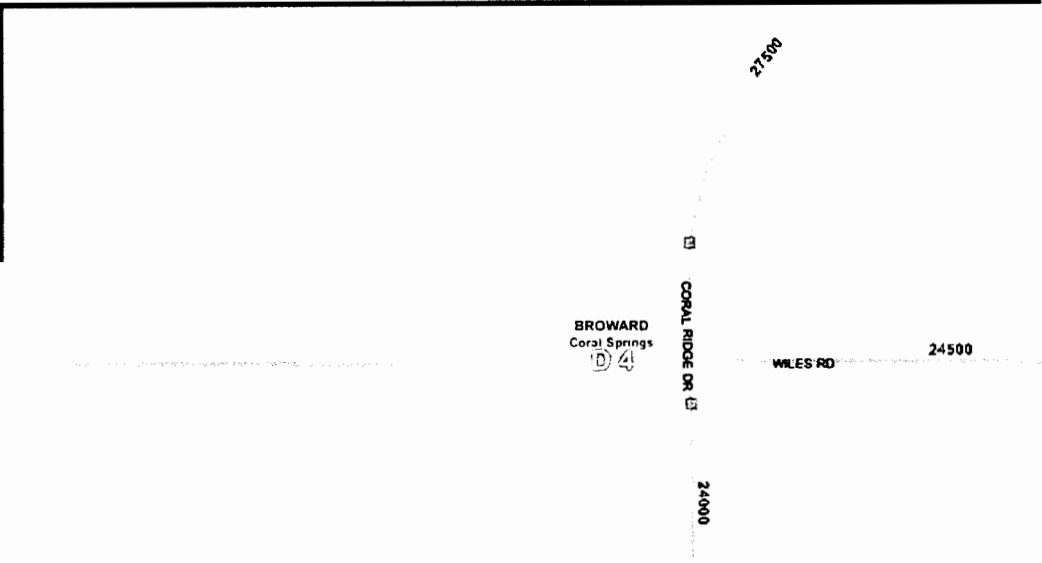

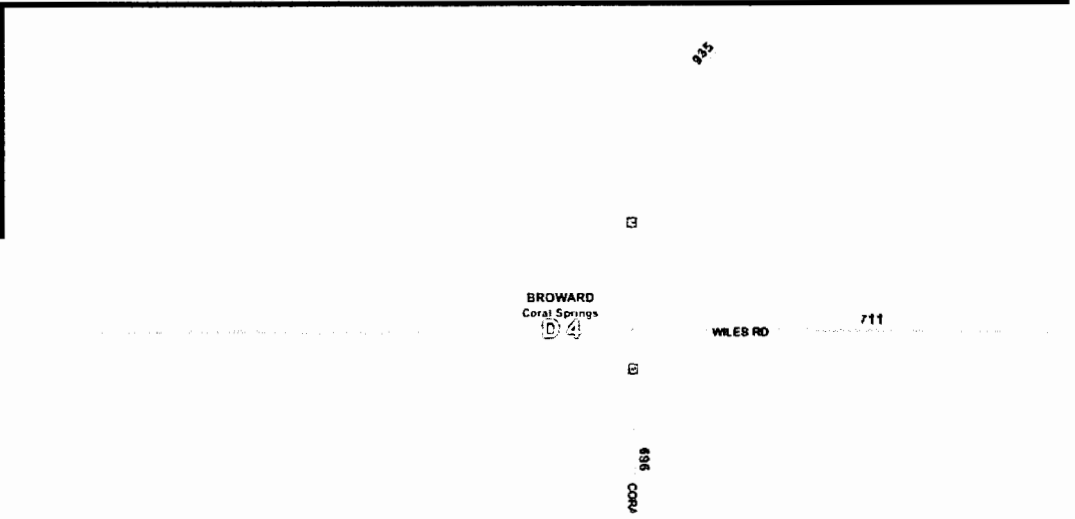

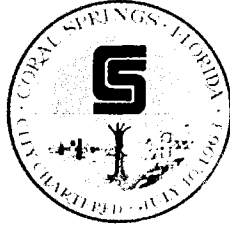
